Home School Agreement

“All children have the right to an education” UNCRC Article 28.

At Great Binfields Primary we believe that all children have the right to be challenged through a high-quality education that fully develops their personality and talents and encourages respect for others. To achieve this, we recognise the following responsibilities:

School Staff & Governors’ responsibilities

- To provide regular information regarding the children’s education and school events.
- To be available to discuss a child’s progress at appropriate times.
- To teach a creative and flexible curriculum matched to each individual’s needs.

Pupils’ responsibilities

- To come to school in correct, named uniform; on time by 8.40am; with necessary equipment e.g., correct uniform or PE kit / book bag / water bottle / packed lunch.
- To have respect for themselves, others, people’s property and the school environment.
- To be polite, truthful and honest to everyone in the school community.
- To work hard and try their best to achieve during lessons, and with home learning.

Family adults’ responsibilities

- To ensure your child attends school every day (provide prompt explanation of absence by 9am, contact school on first day and every day of absence).
- To make sure he/she arrives on time by 8.40am, ready for registration at 8.45am.
- Support the school’s policies and our behaviour code.
- To encourage him/her to have a positive attitude towards learning.
- To attend open evenings and parent’s evenings, and respond to reports and letters.
- To inform the school of any personal circumstances that may affect your child’s education.
- To assist your child’s progress through listening to them read regularly and supporting homework tasks.
- To ensure all payments on ScoPay for trips, events, and school lunches (if in KS2) are up to date.

Together we will:

- Co-operate with each other for the benefit of all.
- Adhere to the Home School Agreement.
- Support the child’s learning and social development.
