




A small selection of KS2 SATs questions which highlight the importance of secure multiplication knowledge in order to tackle these problems:

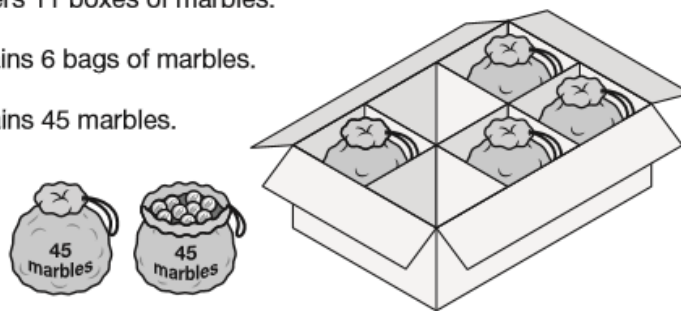
