I don't think there's anything better in the world than a child hearing from a parent or teacher the words, 'Keep trying and you'll get there'.

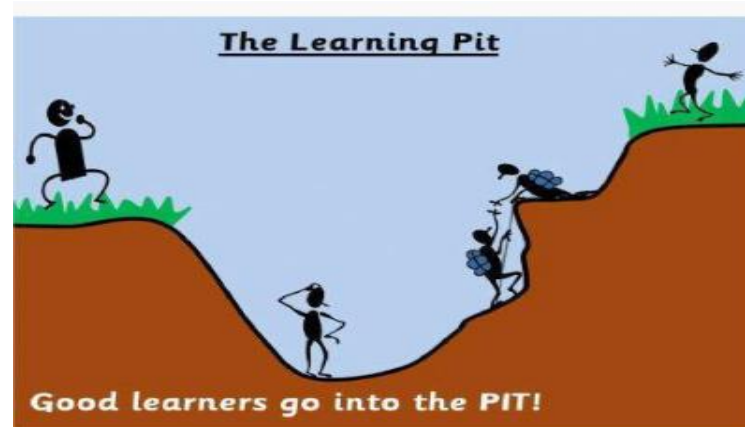
Great learning takes place when you get into the learning pit!
