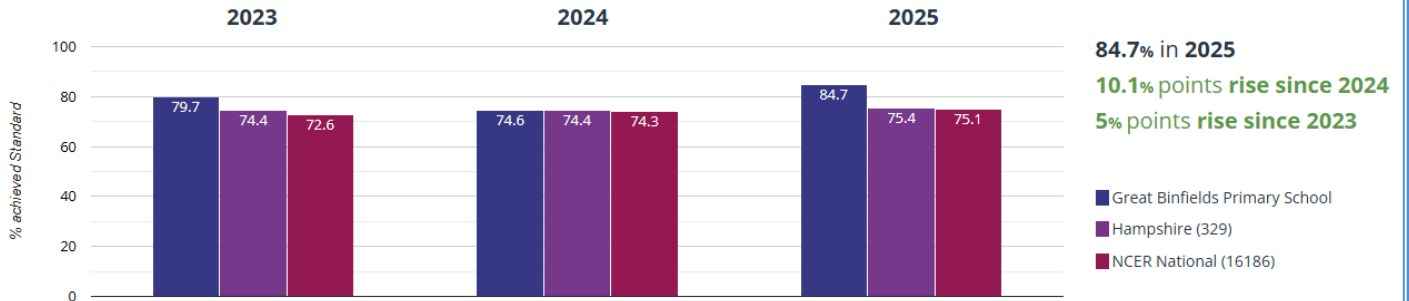




Great Binfields Primary School Year 6 End of KS2 Sat Results 2025

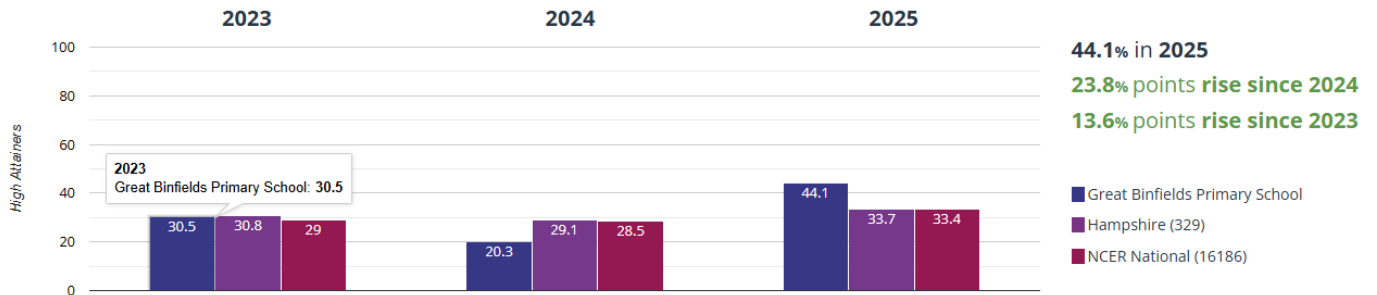
KS2 Reading:

Reading - achieved standard



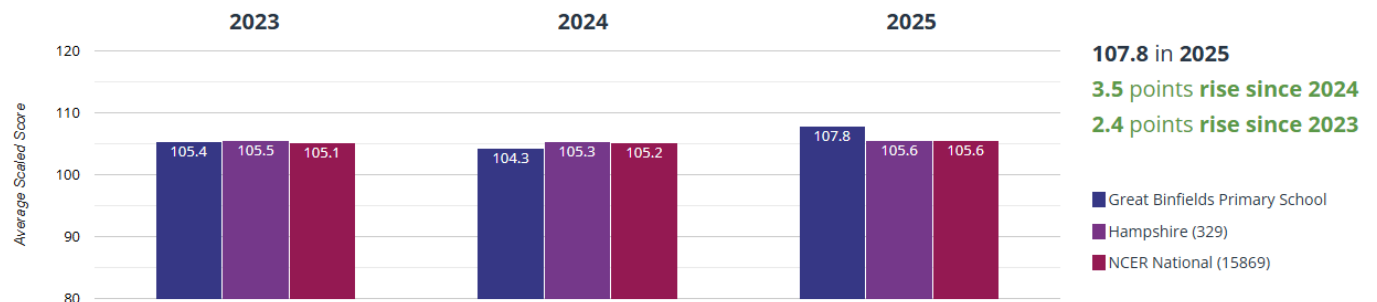
In 2025, 84.7 % of our GBP Year 6 children (51/60) achieved the expected standard (EXS) in reading which is significantly above both National and Hampshire's averages. Reading has been a school improvement area for our whole school and we are delighted that standards are now above both National and Hampshire averages.

Reading - high attainers



44.1% of our Year 6 children (27/60) achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) which is significantly above both Hampshire and National averages.

Reading - average scaled score



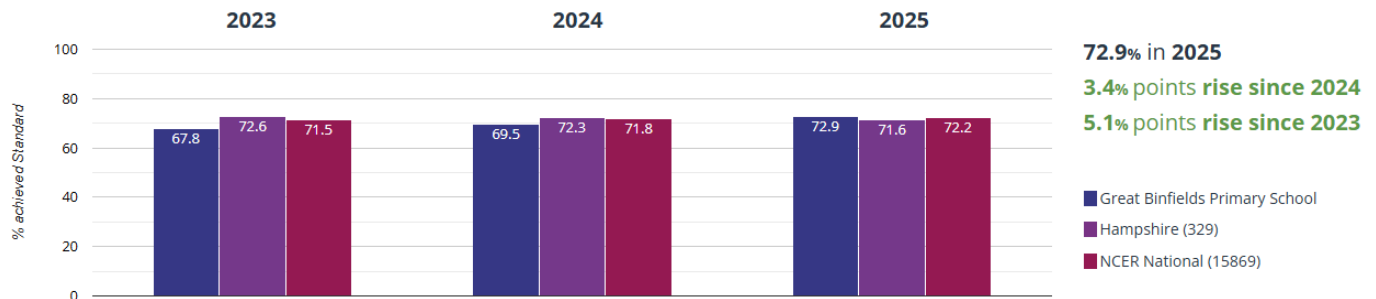
Each child's raw score in the test (27/50 in the Reading test, for example) is turned into a scaled score, based on making comparisons with the other children across the country who took the same test. The scaled scores are centred around 100. That means that:

- A score of 100 means the child is working 'at the expected standard' for a Year 6 child. 80 is the lowest possible score and 120 is the highest.
- A scaled score of 99 or less means they haven't reached the government's 'expected standard'.

In 2025, GBP scaled score is 107.8 which is above both National and Hampshire averages.

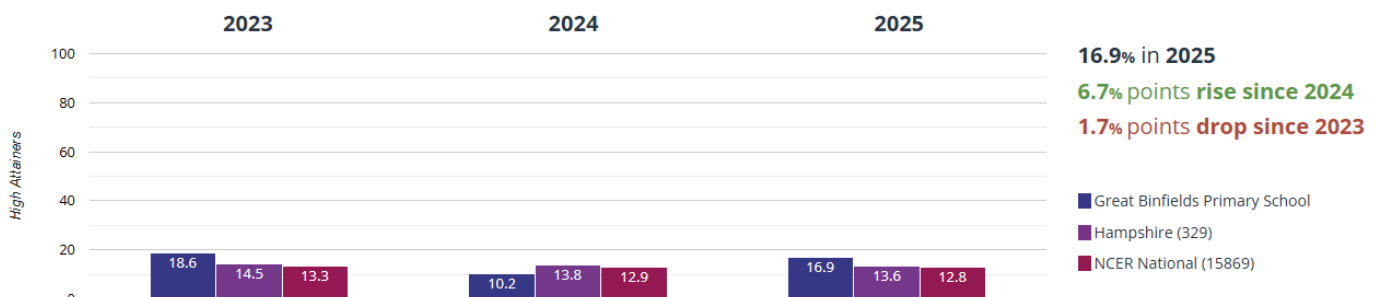
KS2 Writing:

✍ Writing - achieved standard



In 2025, 72.9% of our Year 6 children (44/60) achieved the expected standard in writing which is inline with both the National average of 72.2% and Hampshire's average of 71.6%.

✍ Writing - high attainers

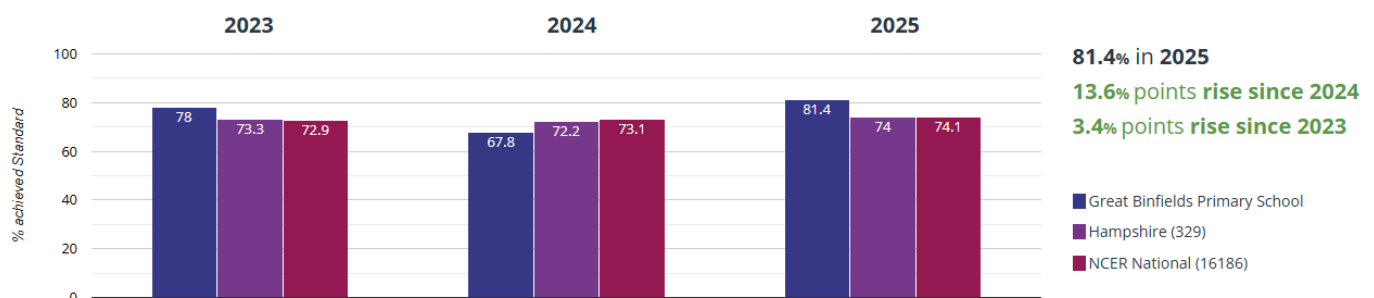


In 2025, 16.9% of our Year 6 children (10/60) achieved the Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Writing which is significantly above National average of 12.8% and Hampshire's average of 13.6%.

Our school improvement planning focus for 2025/2026 will be to maintain % at both ARE and GDS Writing standards in line with both Hampshire and National averages.

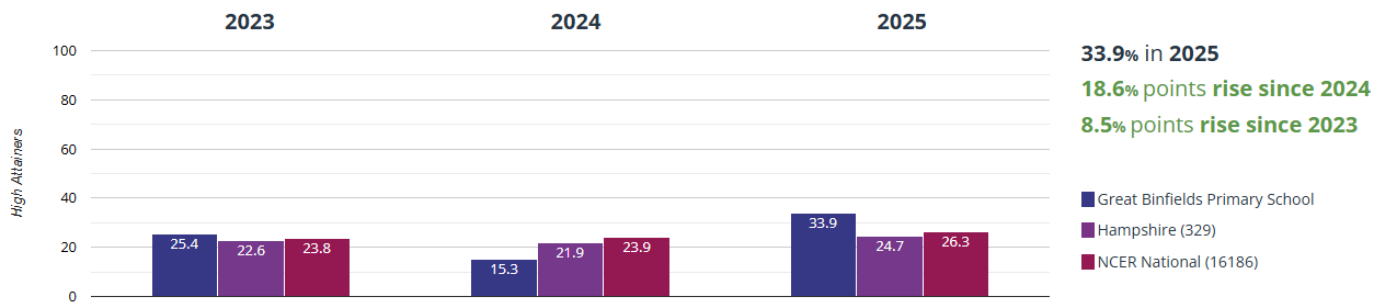
KS2 Maths:

⊕ Maths - achieved standard



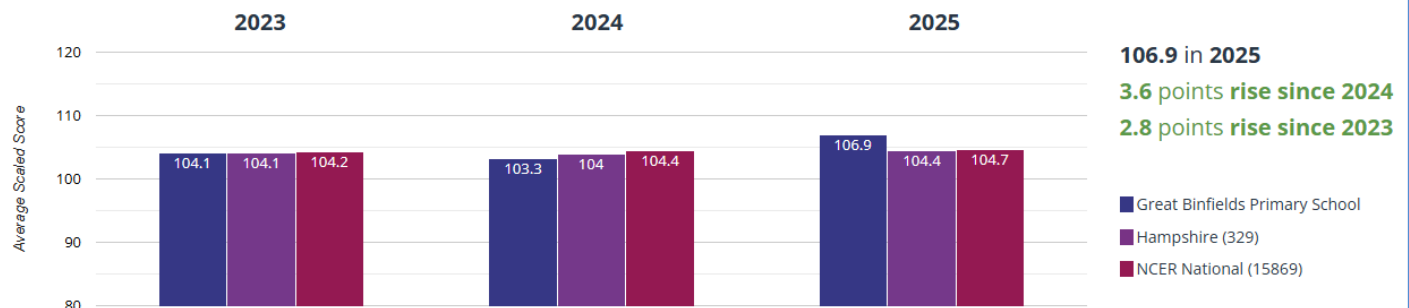
In 2025, 81.4 % of our Year 6 children (49/60) achieved the expected standard in Maths. This attainment is significantly above National average (74%) and Hampshire's average (74%).

⊕ Maths - high attainers



In 2025, 33.9% of our GBP Year 6 (20/60) children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Maths. Great Binfields is significantly above Hampshire's and National standards.

⊕ Maths - average scaled score

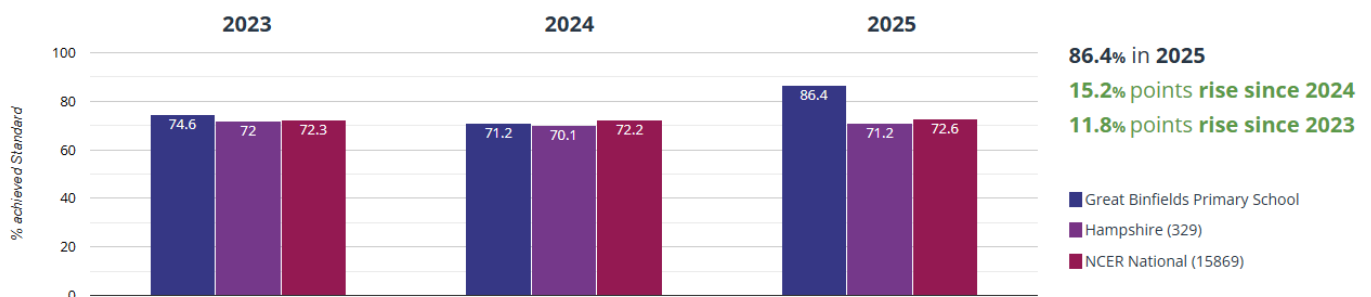


In 2025, GBPS was slightly above both National average and Hampshire average scaled scores.

Our school improvement planning focus for 2025/2026 will be to increase % ARE Maths standards in line with both Hampshire and National averages at both ARE and GDS standard

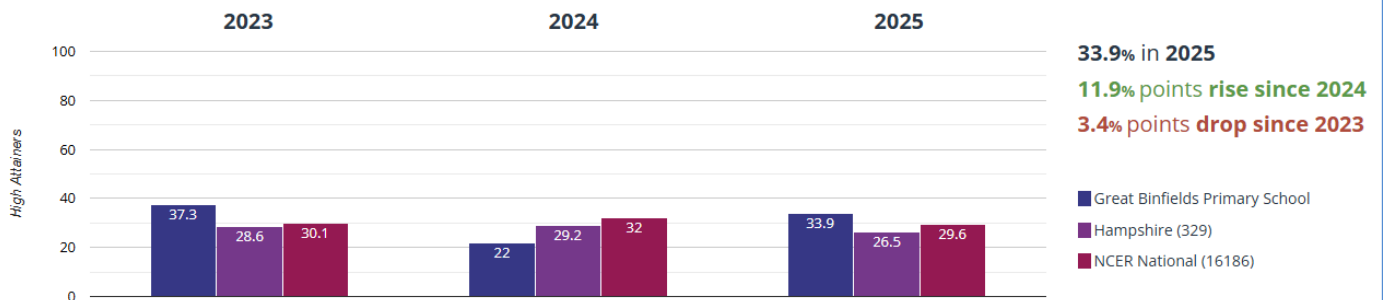
KS2 GPS – Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling:

⊕ GPS - achieved standard



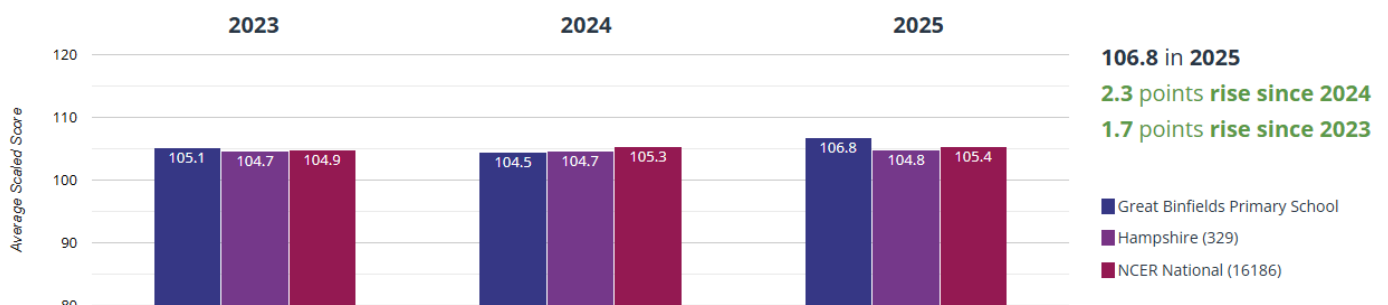
In 2025, 86.4% of our GBP Year 6 children (52/60) achieved the Expected Standard (EXS) in GPS which is significantly above both National (72.6%) and Hampshire's averages (71.2%)

GPS - high attainers



In 2025, 33.9% of our GBP Year 6 children (20/60) achieved the Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in GPS which is above National (29.6%) and significantly above Hampshire's averages (26.5%).

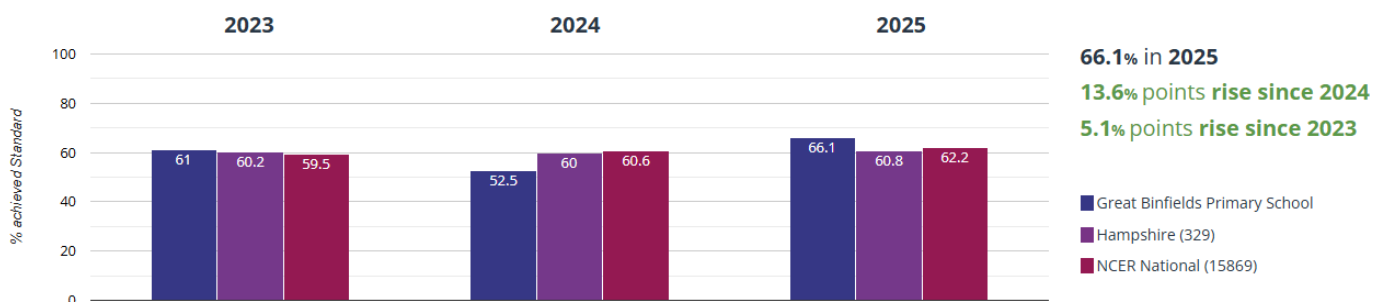
GPS - average scaled score



In 2025, GBPS, National and Hampshire scaled scores are roughly in-line. With GBPS increasing by 2.3%

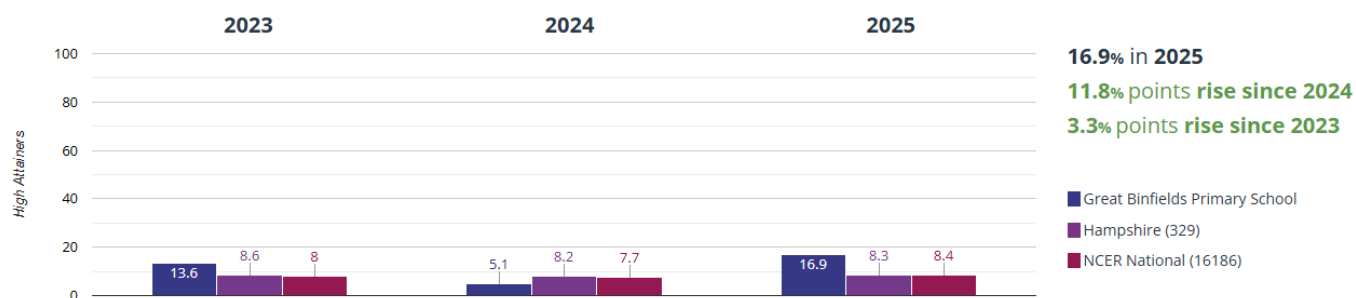
KS2 Combined results (Reading, Writing and Maths)

RWM - achieved standard



In 2025 - At GBP, 66.1% of the current Year 6 cohort reached the Expected Standard (EXS) in Reading, Writing and Mathematics which is significantly above the National average of 62.2% and the Hampshire average of 60.8%.

RWM - high attainers



In 2025 – 16.9% of the Year 6 children reached the greater depth standard (GDS) in all areas of Reading, Writing and Maths. This level of GDS attainment is significantly the National average (8.3%) and Hampshire’s average of 8.4%.

Re Analysis: December 2025
