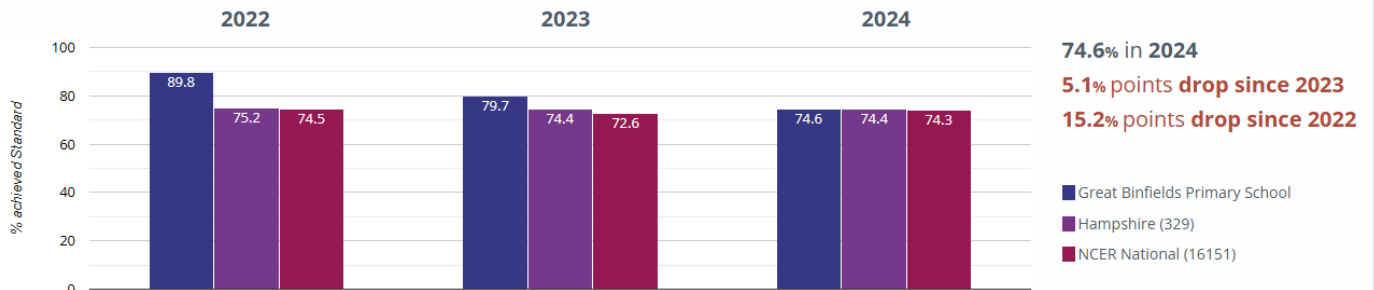




## Great Binfields Primary School Year 6 End of KS2 Sat Results 2024

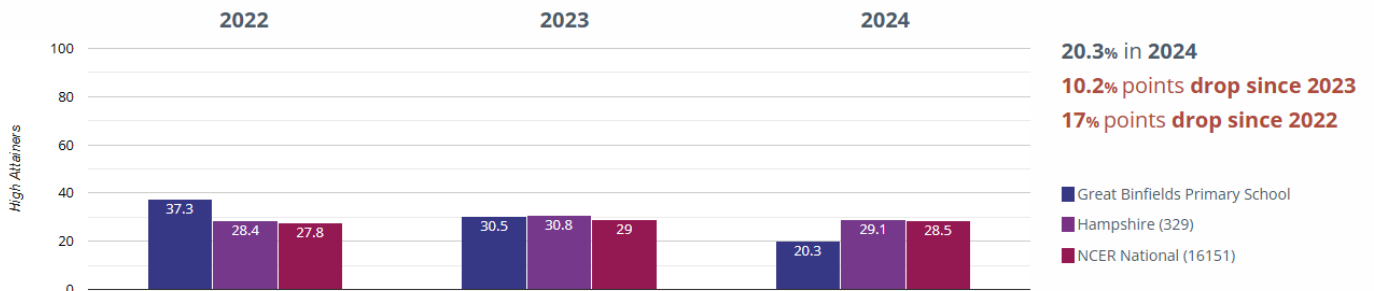
### KS2 Reading:

#### Reading - achieved standard



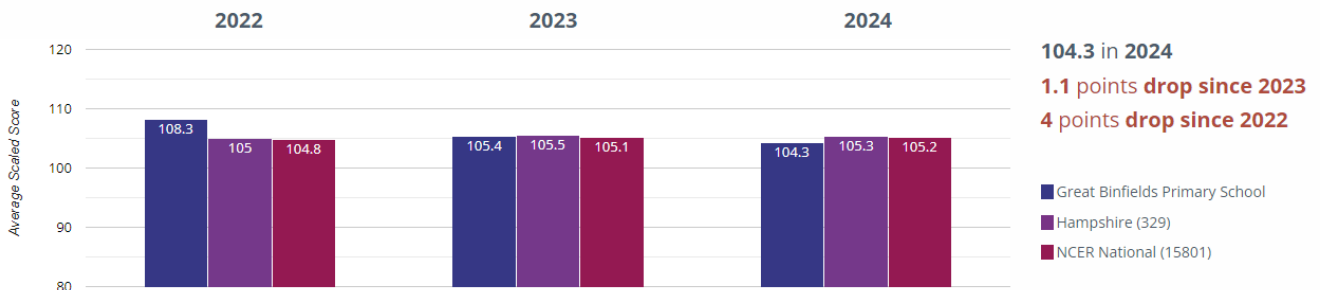
In 2024, 74.6 % of our GBP Year 6 children (44/59) achieved the expected standard (EXS) in reading which is in line with National and Hampshire's averages. Reading has been a school improvement area for our whole school and we are delighted that standards are now above both National and Hampshire averages.

#### Reading - high attainers



20.3% of our Year 6 children (12/59) achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) which is below both Hampshire and National averages. This will be a target for the School Improvement Plan for 2024/2025.

#### Reading - average scaled score



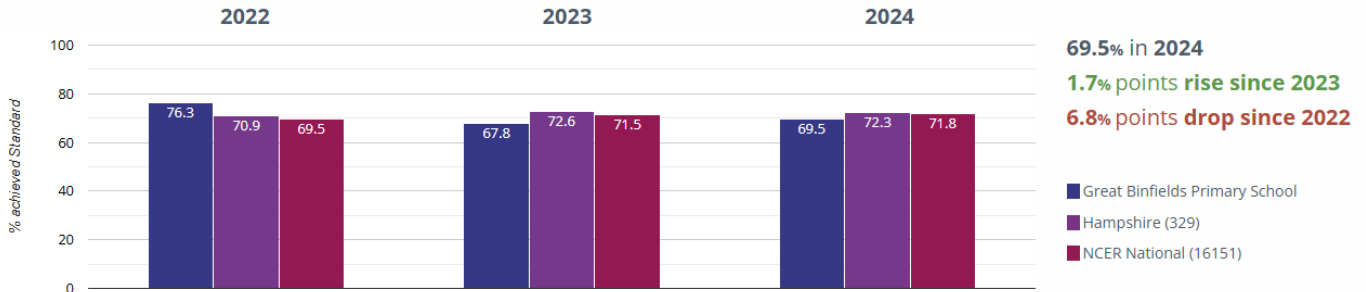
Each child's raw score in the test (27/50 in the Reading test, for example) is turned into a scaled score, based on making comparisons with the other children across the country who took the same test. The scaled scores are centred around 100. That means that:

- A score of 100 means the child is working 'at the expected standard' for a Year 6 child. 80 is the lowest possible score and 120 is the highest.
- A scaled score of 99 or less means they haven't reached the government's 'expected standard'.

In 2024, GBP scaled score is 104.3 which is slightly below both National and Hampshire averages.

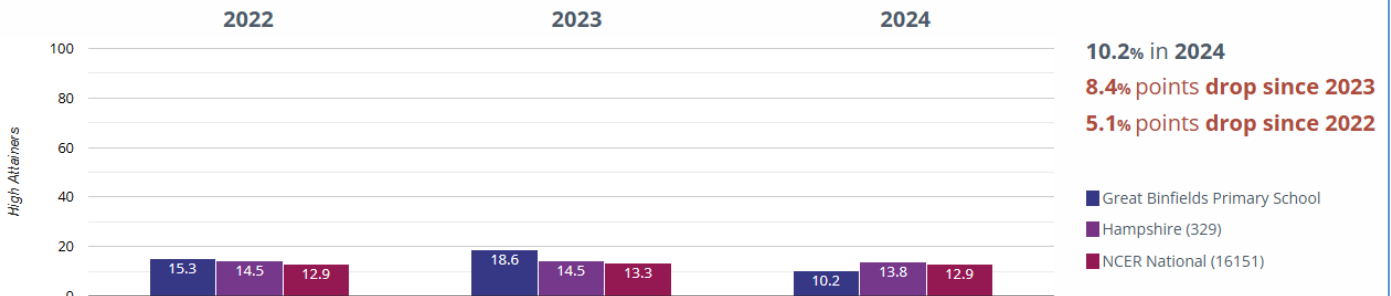
### KS2 Writing:

#### ✍ Writing - achieved standard



In 2024, 69.5% of our Year 6 children (41/59) achieved the expected standard in writing which is below the National average of 71.8% and Hampshire's average of 72.3%.

#### ✍ Writing - high attainers

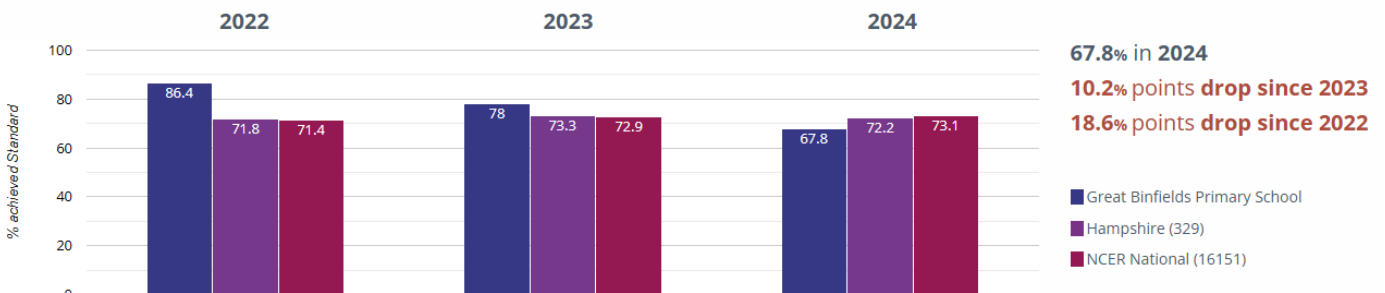


In 2024, 10.2% of our Year 6 children (6/59) achieved the Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Writing which is below National average of 12.9% and Hampshire's average of 13.8%.

*Our school improvement planning focus for 2024/2025 will be to increase % ARE Writing standards in line with both Hampshire and National averages and to maintain GDS %.*

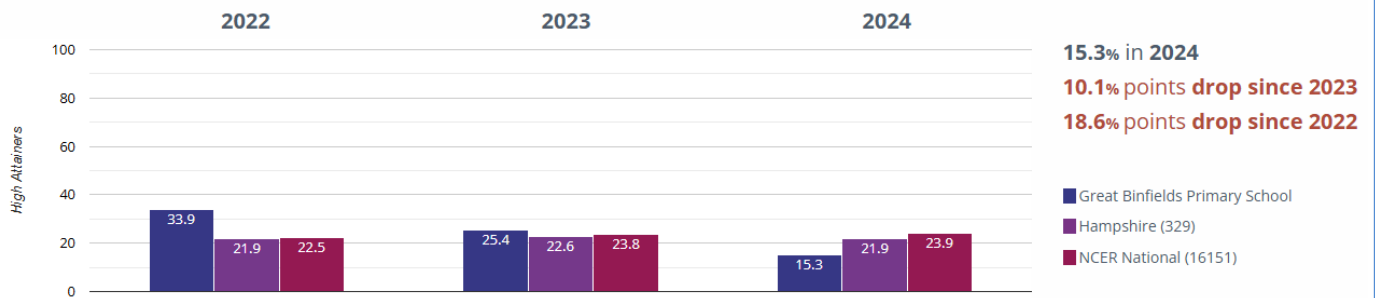
### KS2 Maths:

#### ⊕ Maths - achieved standard



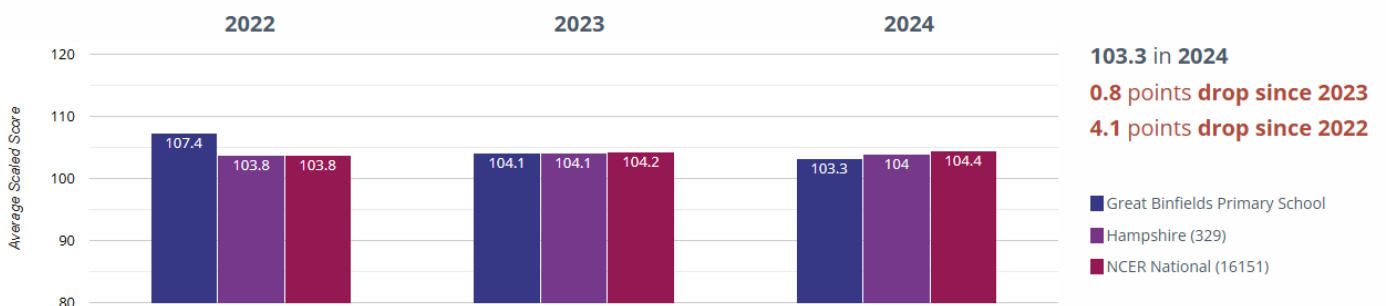
In 2024, 67.8% of our Year 6 children (40/59) achieved the expected standard in Maths. This attainment is below the National average (73.1%) and Hampshire's average (72.2%).

### + Maths - high attainers



In 2024, 15.3% of our GBP Year 6 (9/59) children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Maths. Great Binfields is significantly below Hampshire's and National standards.

### + Maths - average scaled score

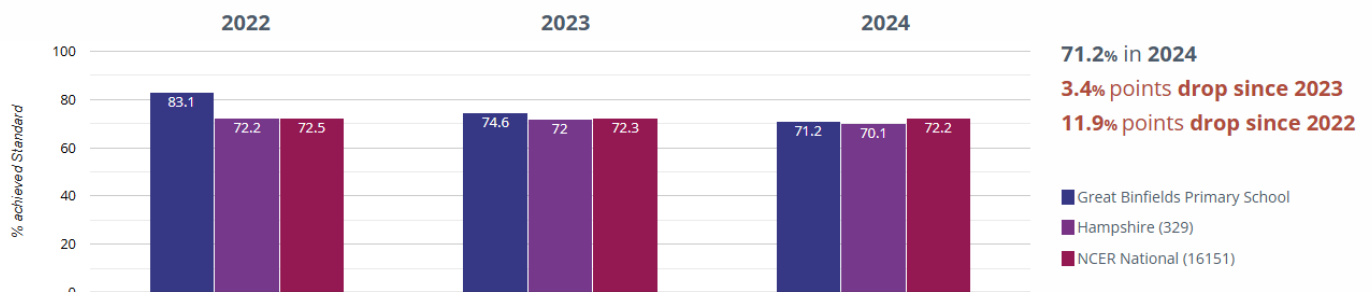


In 2024, GBPS, National average and Hampshire average scaled scores were all in-line.

*Our school improvement planning focus for 2024/2025 will be to increase % ARE Maths standards in line with both Hampshire and National averages at both ARE and GDS standard*

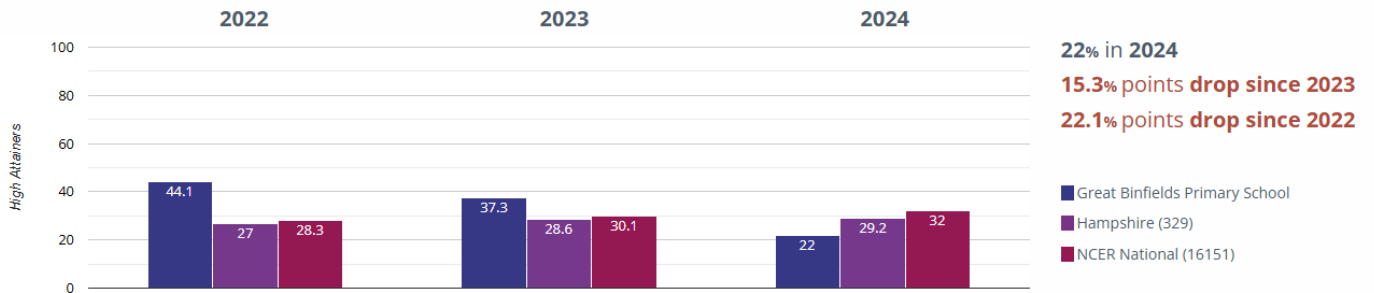
## KS2 GPS – Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling:

### ? GPS - achieved standard



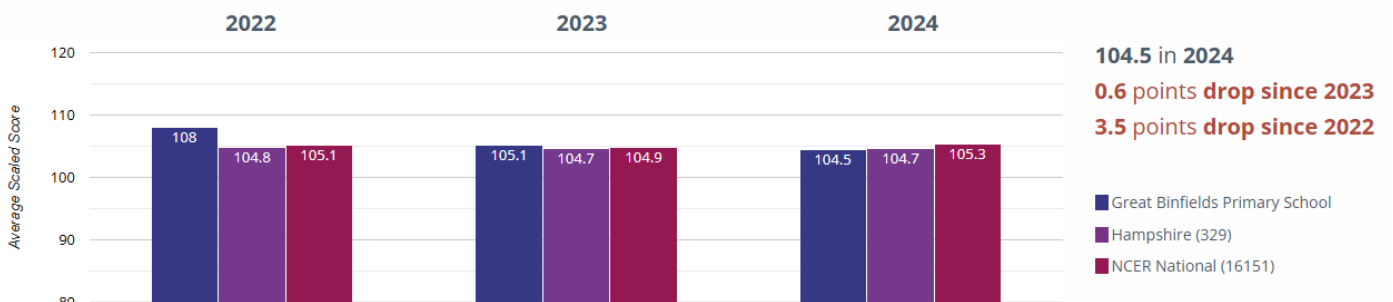
In 2024, 71.2% of our GBP Year 6 children (42/59) achieved the Expected Standard (EXS) in GPS which is in-line with both National (72.2%) and Hampshire's averages (70.1%)

### ? GPS - high attainers



In 2024, 22% of our GBP Year 6 children (13/59) achieved the Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in GPS which is below National (32%) and Hampshire's averages (29.2%).

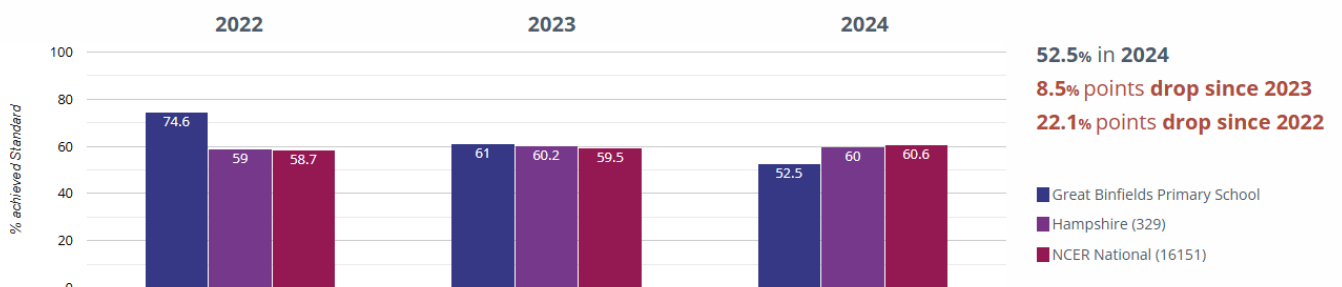
### ? GPS - average scaled score



In 2024, GBPS, National and Hampshire scaled scores are all in-line.

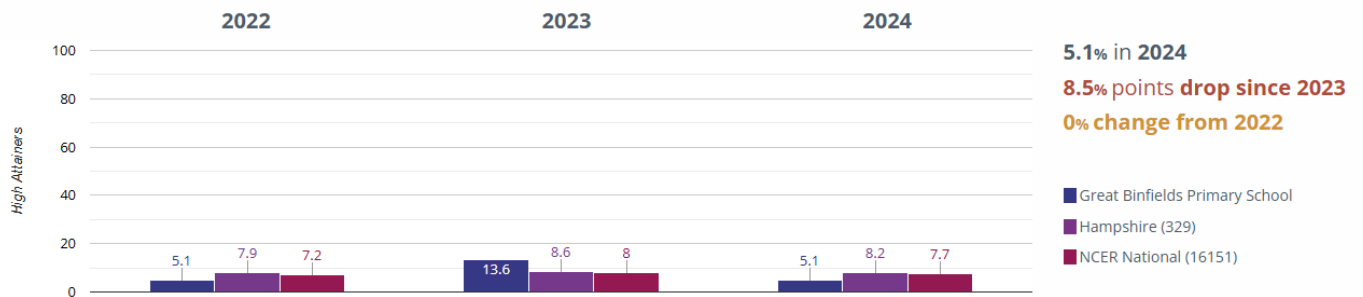
### KS2 Combined results (Reading, Writing and Maths)

#### 📊 RWM - achieved standard



In 2024 - At GBP, 52.5% of the current Year 6 cohort reached the Expected Standard (EXS) in Reading, Writing and Mathematics which is below the National average of 60.6% and the Hampshire average of 60%.

## RWM - high attainers



In 2024 – 5.1% of the Year 6 children reached the greater depth standard (GDS) in all areas of Reading, Writing and Maths. This level of GDS attainment is below the national average (7.7%) and Hampshire's average of 8.2%.
