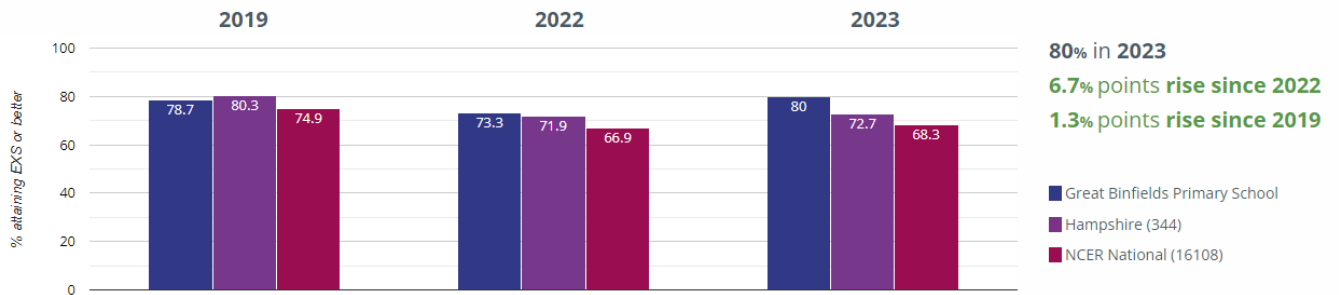




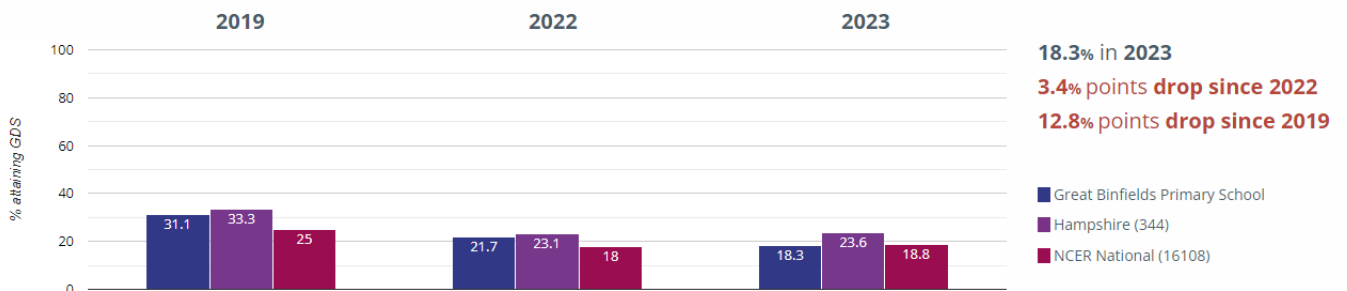
Great Binfields Primary School Year 2 End of KS1 SAT Results 2022

Reading - attaining EXS or better



In 2023, 80% of our GBP Year 2 children (48/60) achieved the expected standard (EXS) in Reading which is above the National average of 68.3%. Reading attainment is also 7.3% higher than Hampshire's average of 72.7%.

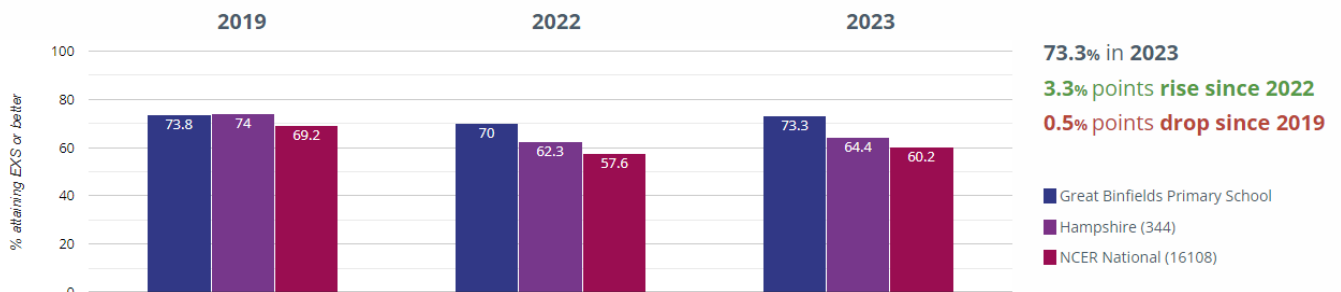
Reading - attaining GDS



In 2023, 18.3% of our Year 2 children (11/60) achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Reading. This GDS attainment places us in-line with National averages but 5.3% lower than Hampshire averages.

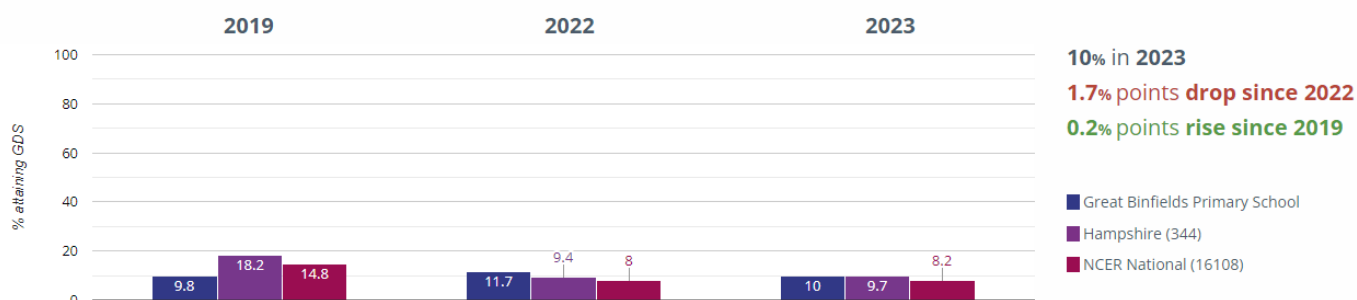
Our school improvement planning focus for 2023/204 will be to achieve % ARE and GDS scores at least in-line with Hampshire averages. Reading attainment will remain a key priority for us so that we achieve standards (ARE and GDS) that are closer to 2019 statistics.

Writing - attaining EXS or better



73.3% of our GBP Year 2 children (44/60) achieved the expected standard in Writing. This years' % scores are considerably above the National average of 60.2% and Hampshire's average of 64.4%. We are pleased that for the past 3 years, writing attainment at GBP has always been above National and Hampshire.

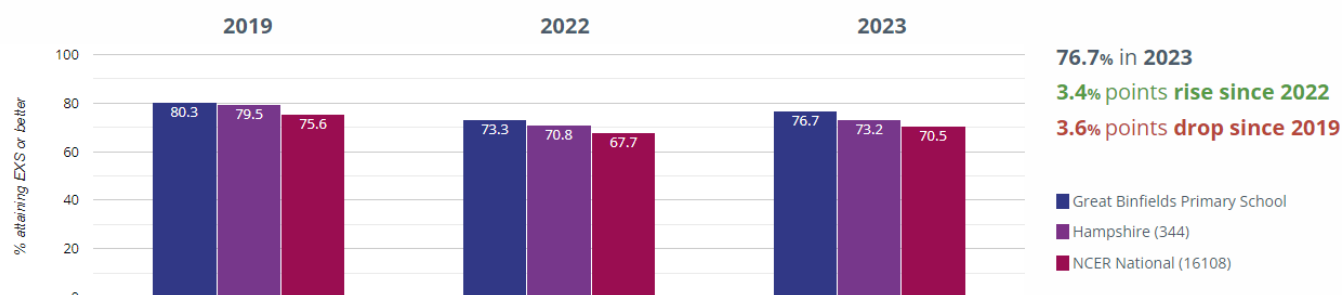
✍ Writing - attaining GDS



10% (6/60) of our Year 2 children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in writing which is 1.8% above National averages and in-line with Hampshire averages. This is particularly pleasing as in previous years GDS stats have lagged behind Hampshire averages.

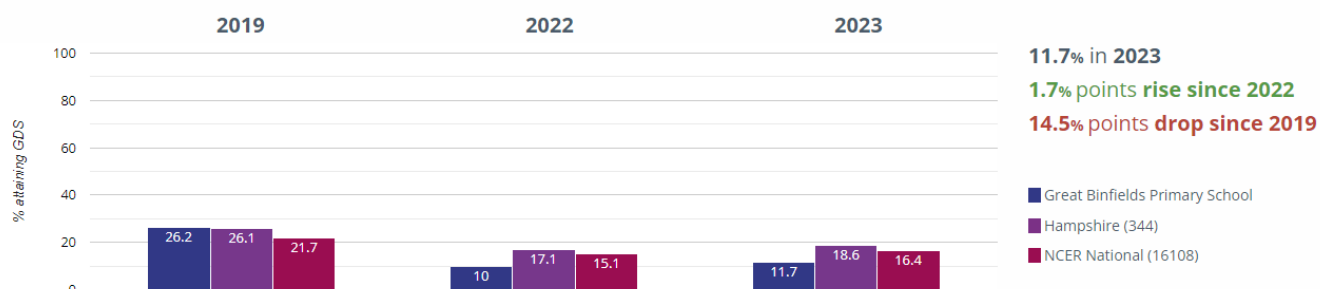
KS1 GDS writing will continue to be part of our school improvement plan focus linked closely with reading for 2023/2024.

+ Maths - attaining EXS or better



In 2023, 76.7% of our GBP Year 2 children (46/60) achieved the expected standard in Maths and this compares favourably to the National average figure of 70.5% and also Hampshire's average of 73.2%.

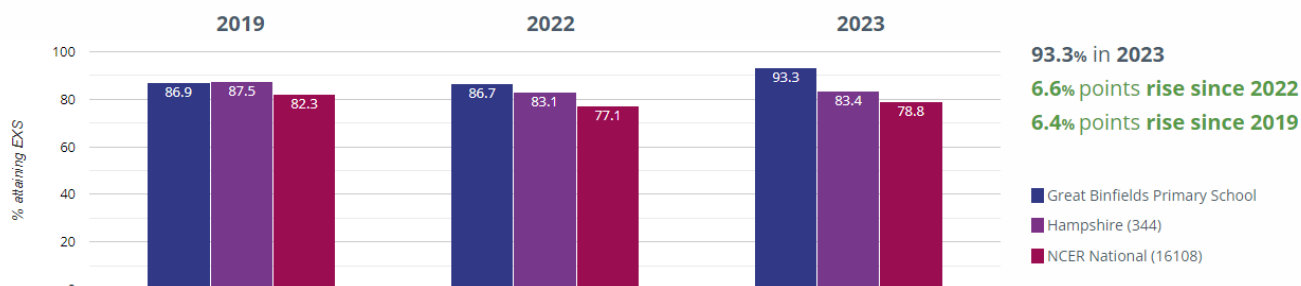
+ Maths - attaining GDS



In 2023 we have seen a slight increase in the number of children achieving GDS standards (7/60) as in the previous year. 11.7% of our Year 2 children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Maths which is lower than both National and Hampshire's averages.

KS1 GDS Maths will be part of our school improvement plan focus linked closely with GDS Maths in KS2 for 2023/2024.

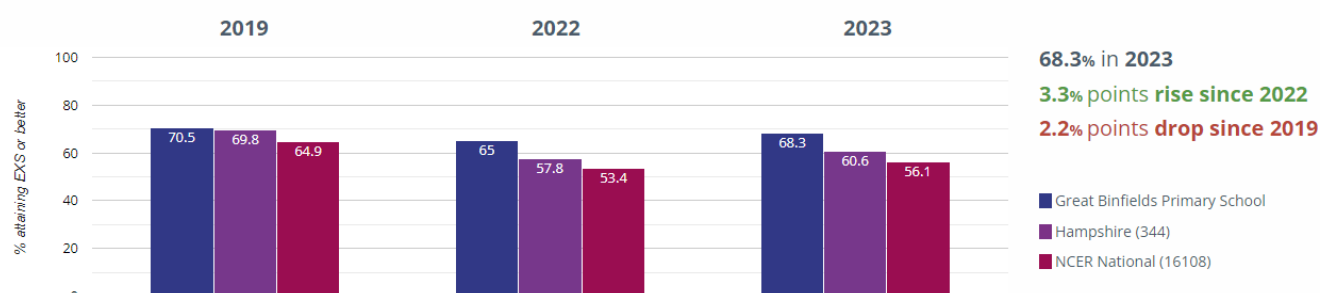
Science - attaining EXS



In 2023, 93.3% of our GBP Year 2 children (56/60) achieved the expected standard in Science and this compares favourably to the National average figure of 78.8% and Hampshire's average of 83.4%.

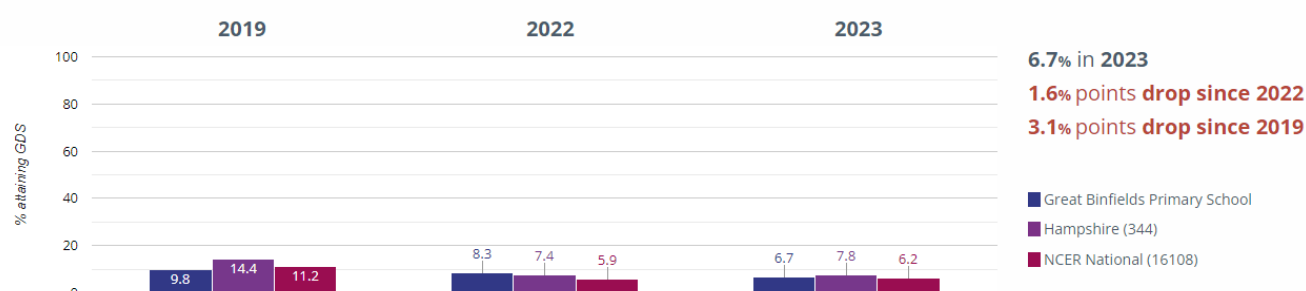
Combined results (Reading, Writing and Maths)

RWM - attaining EXS or better



2023 - At GBP, 68.3% of the current Year 2 2023 cohort reached the Expected Standard (EXS) in Reading, Writing and Mathematics which is above the National average of 53.1% and the Hampshire average of 60.6%. This has now been the case for the past 3 years.

RWM - attaining GDS

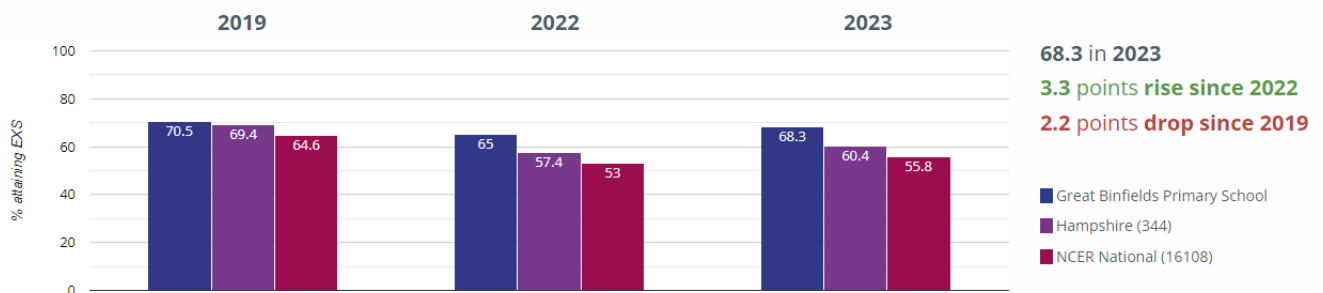


In 2023, 6.7% of our Year 2 children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Reading, Writing and Maths which is slightly above National (by 0.5%); but below Hampshire's averages by 1.1% this year.

Our school improvement planning focus for 2023/2024 will be to achieve % GDS scores at least in-line with Hampshire averages once again.

Combined results (Reading, Writing, Maths and Science)

📖 Reading, Writing, Maths and Science - attaining EXS



2023 - At GBP, 68.3% of the current (Year 2 2023) cohort reached the Expected Standard (EXS) in Reading, Writing Mathematics and Science which is above the National average of 55.8% and the Hampshire average of 60.4%. This has now been the case for the past 3 year's data.
