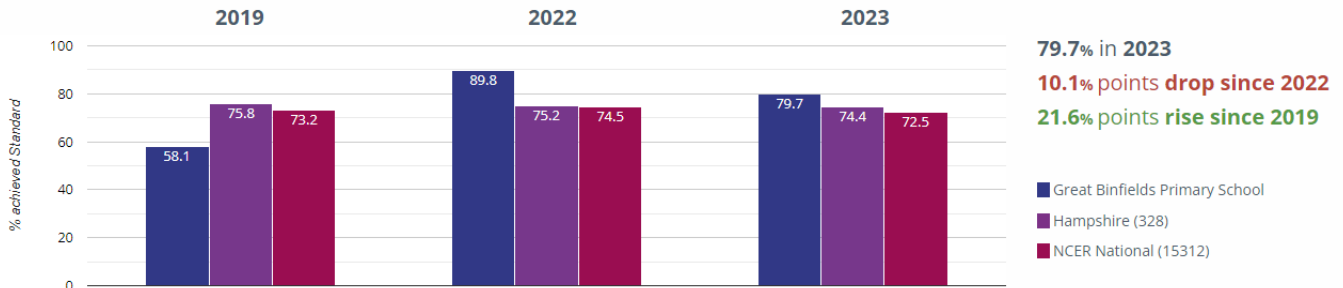




## Great Binfields Primary School Year 6 End of KS2 Sat Results 2023

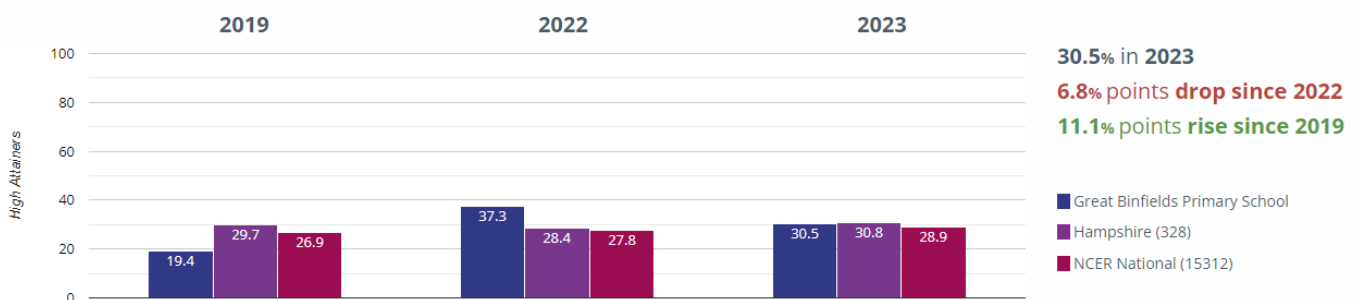
### KS2 Reading:

#### Reading - achieved standard



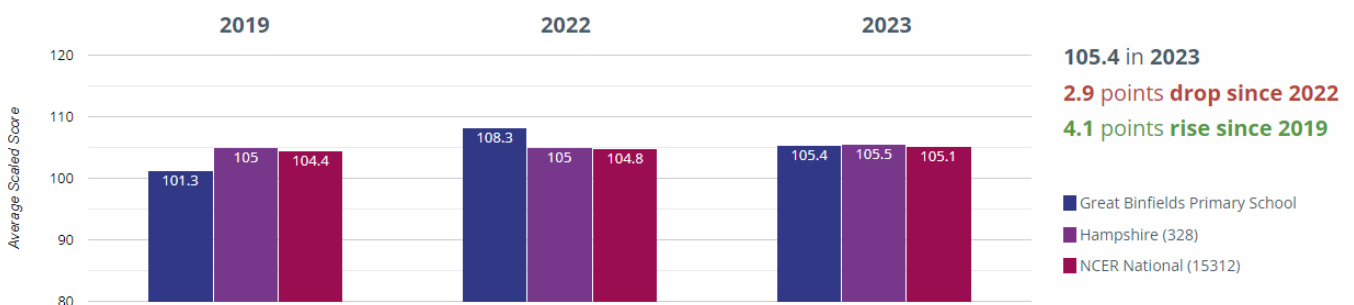
In 2023, 79.7 % of our GBP Year 6 children (47/59) achieved the expected standard (EXS) in reading which is significantly above the National average of 72.5% and Hampshire's average of 74.4%. Reading has been a school improvement area for our whole school and we are delighted that standards are now above both National and Hampshire averages.

#### Reading - high attainers



30.5% of our Year 6 children (18/59) achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in reading which is 1.6% above National average (28.9%) and in-line with Hampshire averages.

#### Reading - average scaled score



Each child's raw score in the test (32/50 in the Reading test, for example) is turned into a scaled score, based on making comparisons with the other children across the country who took the same test. The scaled scores are centred around 100. That means that:

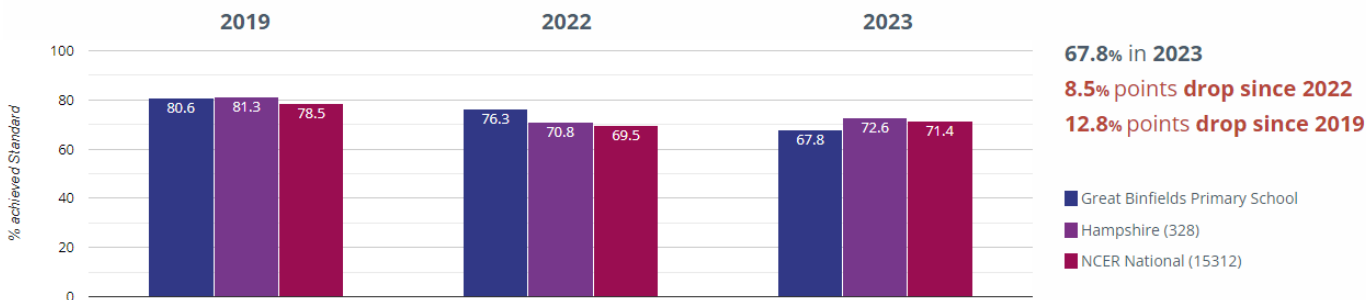
- A score of 100 means the child is working 'at the expected standard' for a Year 6 child. 80 is the lowest possible score and 120 is the highest.
- A scaled score of 99 or less means they haven't reached the government's 'expected standard'.

In 2023, GBP scaled score is 105.4 which is in-line with both National and Hampshire averages.

Our school improvement planning focus for 2023/2024 will be to maintain % ARE and GDS scores so that GBPS is in-line with Hampshire and above National averages.

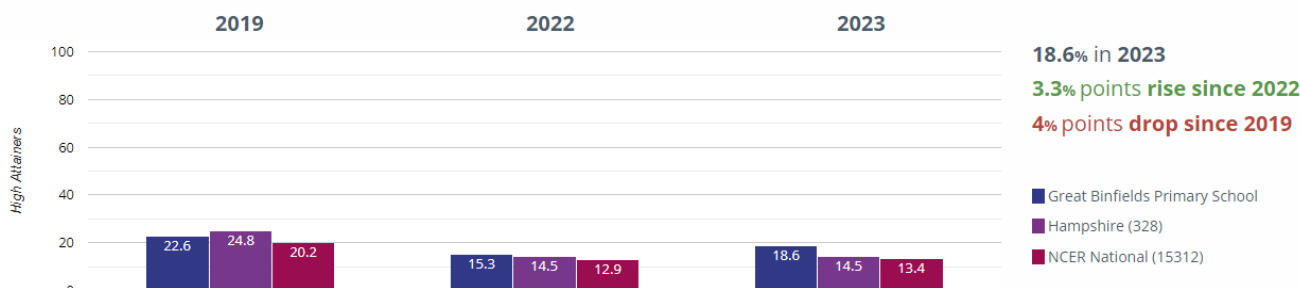
## KS2 Writing:

### Writing - achieved standard



In 2023, 67.8% of our Year 6 children (40/59) achieved the expected standard in writing which is below the National average of 71.4% and Hampshire's average of 72.6%.

### Writing - high attainers

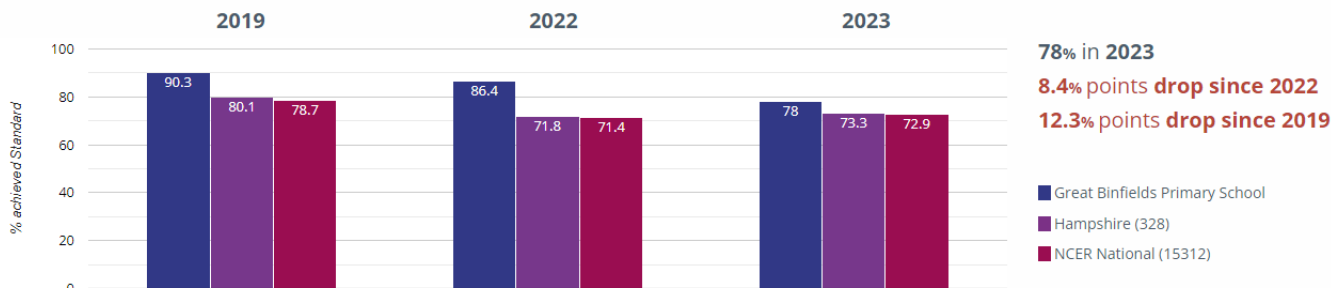


In 2023, 18.6% of our Year 6 children (11/59) achieved the Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Writing which compares favourably to the National average of 13.4% and Hampshire's average of 14.5%.

Our school improvement planning focus for 2023/2024 will be to increase % ARE Writing standards in line with both Hampshire and National averages and to maintain GDS %.

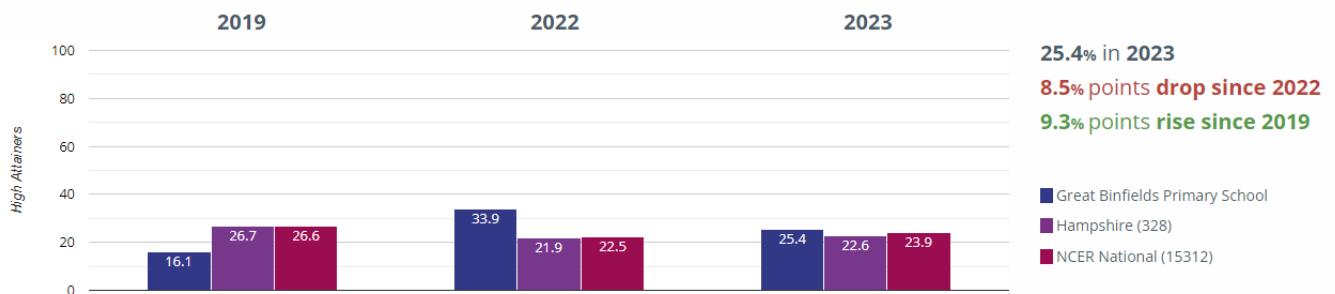
## KS2 Maths:

### Maths - achieved standard



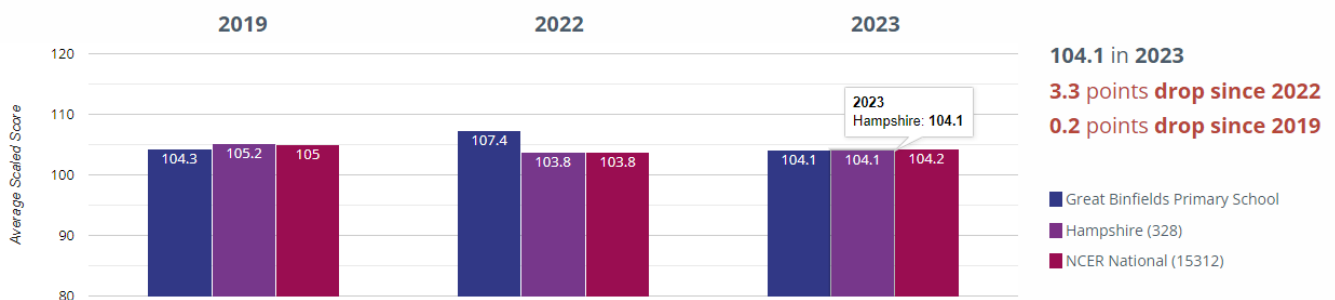
In 2023, 78% of our Year 6 children (46/59) achieved the expected standard in Maths. This attainment is above the National average (72.9%) and Hampshire's average (73.3%). This has been the case for the last 3 years of Maths SATs.

### + Maths - high attainers



In 2023, 35.4% of our GBP Year 6 (21/59) children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Maths. This compares favourably to the Hampshire's and National standards. GBP GDS averages are above National and Hampshire averages.

### + Maths - average scaled score

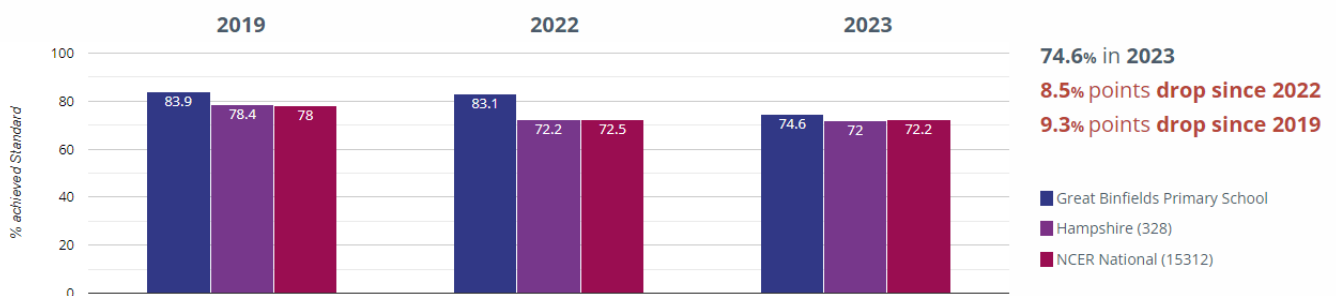


In 2023, GBPS, National average and Hampshire average scaled scores were all in-line.

*Our school improvement planning focus for 2032/2024 will be to maintain our standards % ARE and GDS in Maths.*

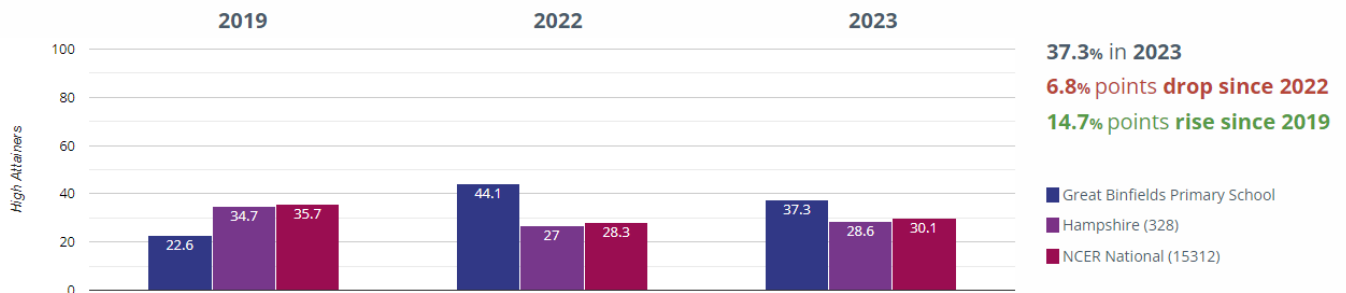
## KS2 GPS – Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling:

### ? GPS - achieved standard



In 2023, 74.6% of our GBP Year 6 children (44/59) achieved the Expected Standard (EXS) in GPS which is favourably above both National (72.2%) and Hampshire's averages (72.%)

## GPS - high attainers



In 2023, 37.3% of our GBP Year 6 children (22/59) achieved the Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in GPS which is significantly above National (30.7%) and Hampshire's averages (28.6%).

## GPS - average scaled score

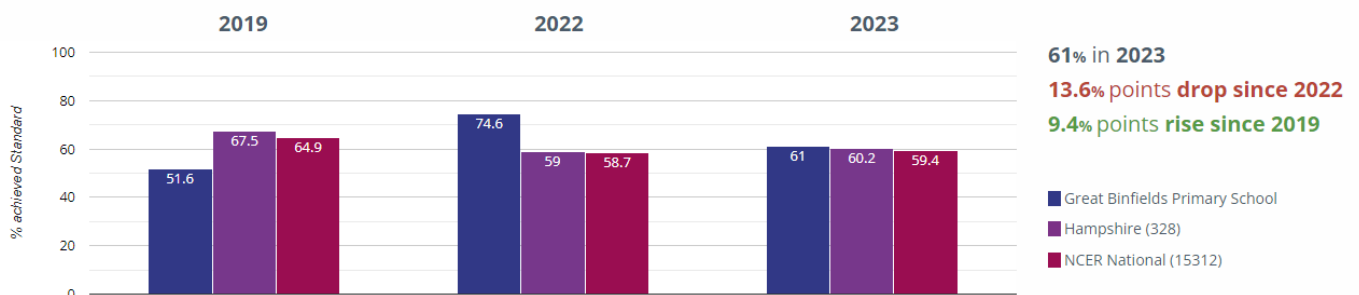


In 2023, GBPS, National and Hampshire scaled score are all in-line.

*Our school improvement planning focus for 2023/2024 will be to maintain our standards % ARE and GDS GPS so they continue to be in line with or above both national and Hampshire scores.*

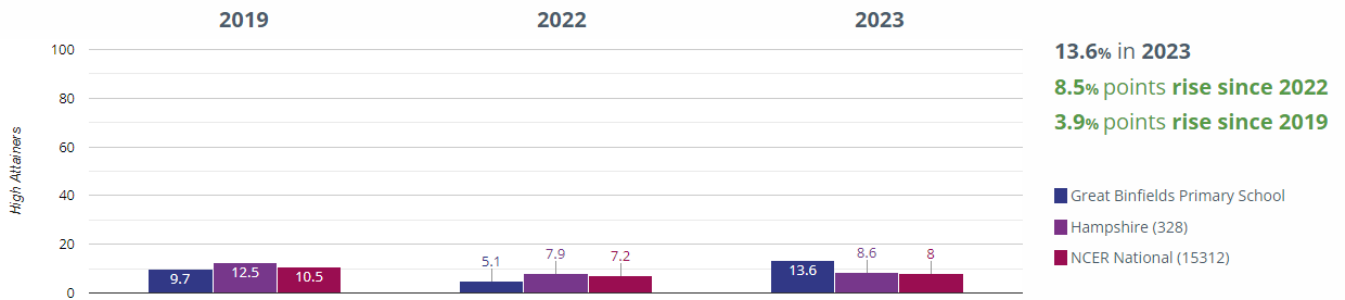
## KS2 Combined results (Reading, Writing and Maths)

### RWM - achieved standard



In 2023 - At GBP, 61% of the current Year 6 2022 cohort reached the Expected Standard (EXS) in Reading, Writing and Mathematics which is in-line with the National average of 59.4% and the Hampshire average of 60.2%.

## RWM - high attainers



In 2023 – 13.6% of the Year 6 children in the 2022 cohort reached the greater depth standard (GDS) in all areas of reading, writing and maths. This level of GDS attainment is significantly above the Nationally average (8%) and that of Hampshire’s average of 8.6%.

*Our school improvement planning focus for 2023/2024 will be to continue to achieve % combined GDS scores in-line with Hampshire averages.*
