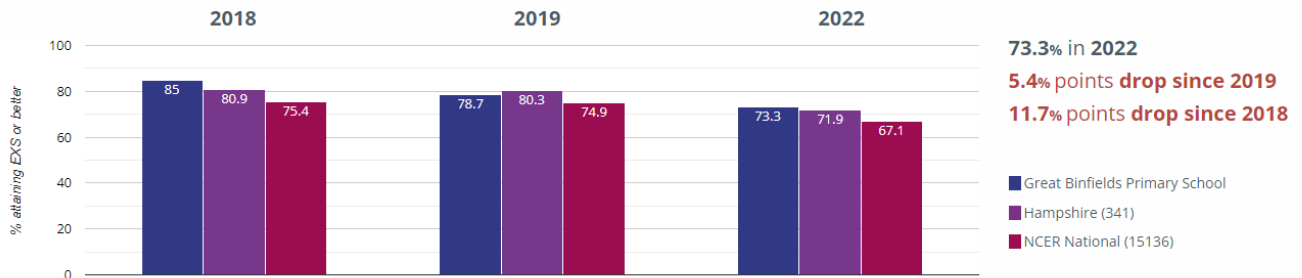




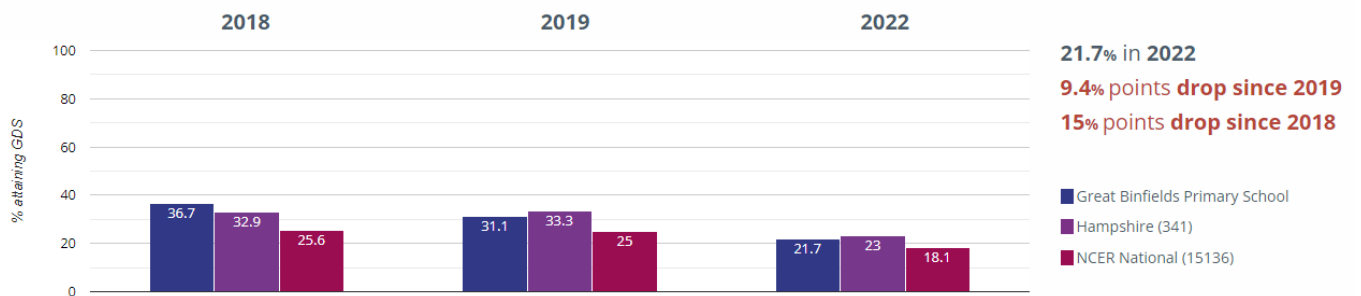
Great Binfields Primary School Year 2 End of KS1 SAT Results 2022

Reading - attaining EXS or better



In 2022, 73.3% of our GBP Year 2 children (44/60) achieved the expected standard (EXS) in Reading which is above the National average of 67.1%. Reading attainment is also 1.4% higher than Hampshire's average of 71.9%.

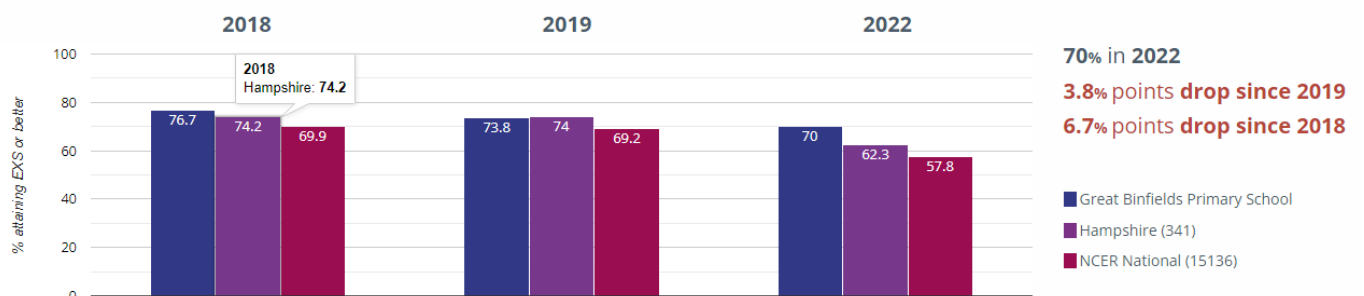
Reading - attaining GDS



In 2022, 21.7% of our Year 2 children (13/60) achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Reading. This GDS attainment places us above National averages (by 3.6%) but 1.3% lower than Hampshire averages.

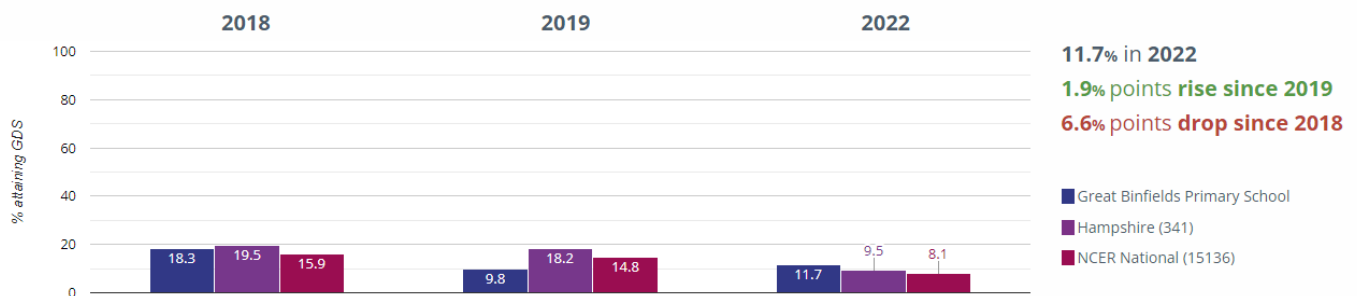
Our school improvement planning focus for 2022/2023 will be to achieve % ARE and GDS scores at least in-line with Hampshire averages. Reading attainment will remain a key priority for us so that we achieve standards (ARE and GDS) that are closer to 2018 statistics.

Writing - attaining EXS or better



70% of our GBP Year 2 children (42/60) achieved the expected standard in Writing. This years' % scores are considerably above the National average of 57.8% and Hampshire's average of 62.3%. We are pleased that for the past 3 years, writing attainment at GBP has always been above National and Hampshire.

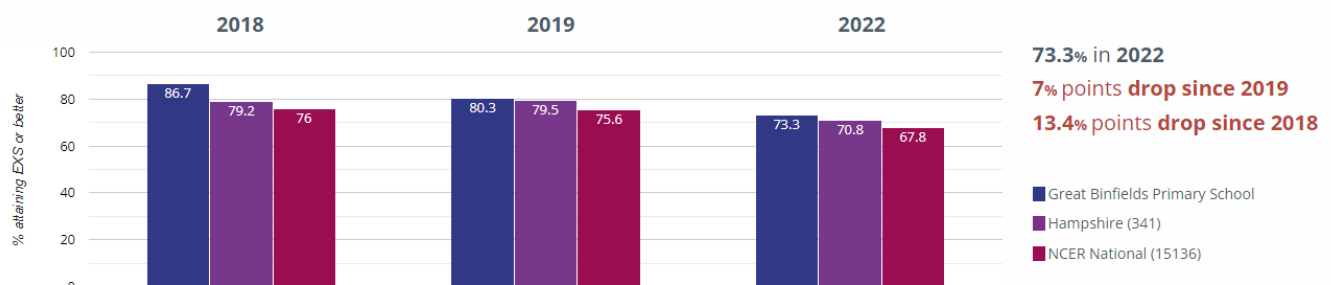
✍ Writing - attaining GDS



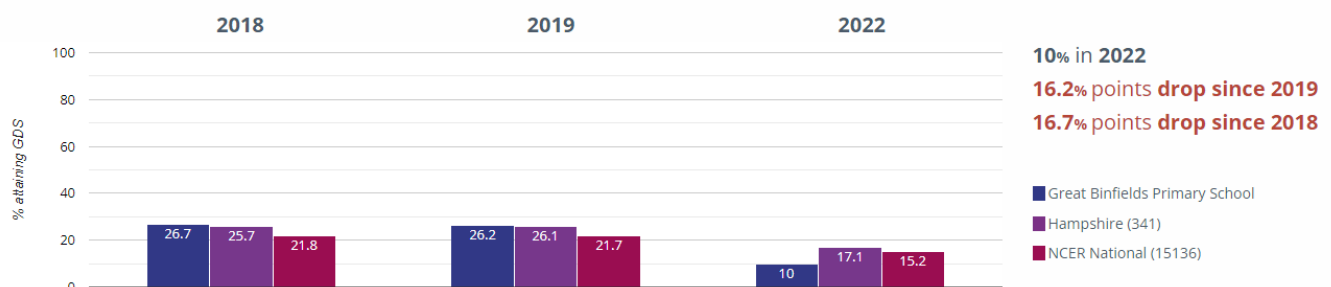
11.7% (7/60) of our Year 2 children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in writing which is 3.6% above National averages and 2.2% above Hampshire averages. This is particularly pleasing as in previous years GDS stats have lagged behind Hampshire averages.

+ Maths - attaining GDS

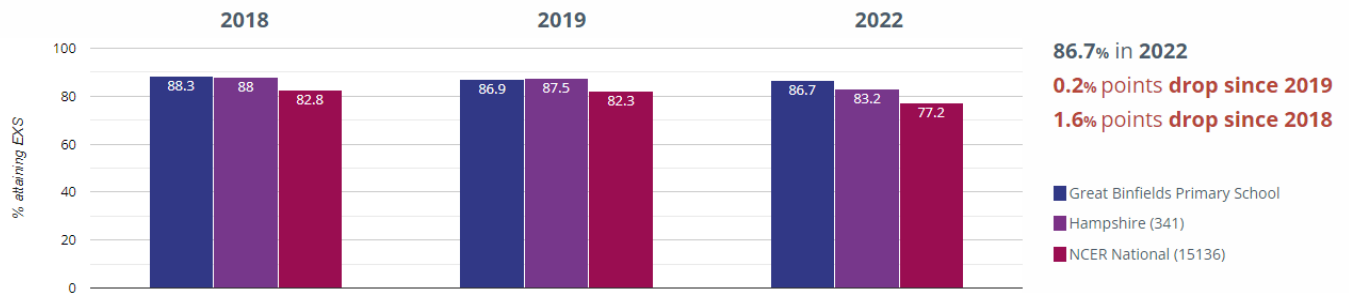


In 2022, 73.3% of our GBP Year 2 children (44/60) achieved the expected standard in Maths and this compares favourably to the National average figure of 67.8% and also Hampshire's average of 70.8%. This has been the case for the past 3 years of data.

In 2022 (6/60) we have seen a decrease in the number of children achieving GDS standards as in the previous year. 10% of our Year 2 children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Maths which is lower than both National and Hampshire's averages.

KS1 GDS Maths will be part of our school improvement plan focus linked closely with GDS Maths in KS2 for 2022/2023

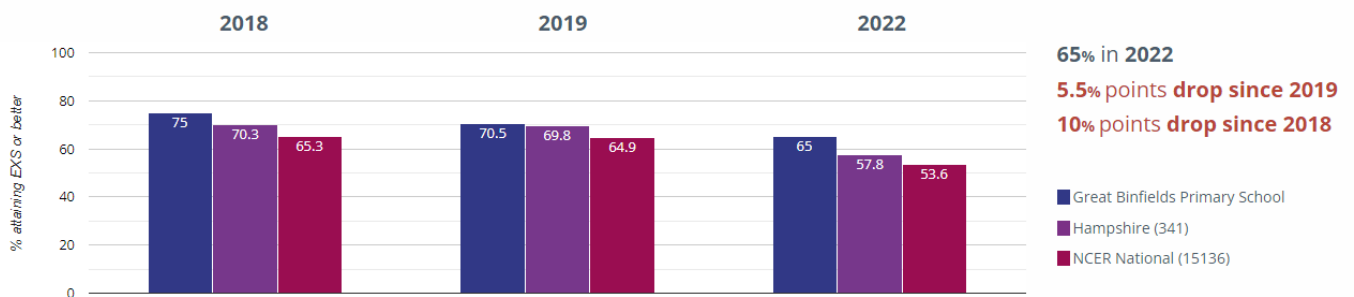
Science - attaining EXS



In 2022, 86.7% of our GBP Year 2 children (52/60) achieved the expected standard in Science and this compares favourably to the National average figure of 77.2% and Hampshire's average of 83.2%. Our attainment standards have remained steady for the past 3 year's data we have.

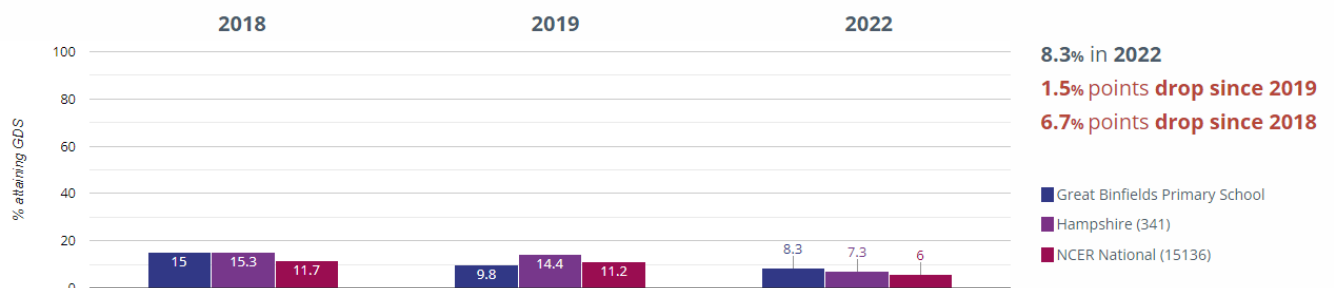
Combined results (Reading, Writing and Maths)

RWM - attaining EXS or better



2022 - At GBP, 65% of the current (Year 2 2022) cohort reached the Expected Standard (EXS) in Reading, Writing and Mathematics which is above the National average of 53.6% and the Hampshire average of 57.8%. This has now been the case for the past 3 year's data.

RWM - attaining GDS

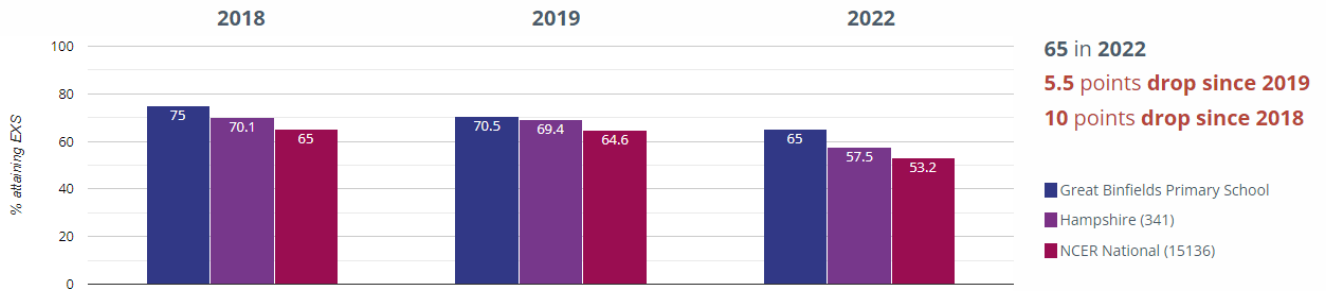


In 2022, 8.3% of our Year 2 children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Reading, Writing and Maths which is above National by 2.3% and Hampshire's averages by 1% this year. This is really pleasing as back in line with historic data pictures prior to 2019.

Our school improvement planning focus for 2022/2023 will be to achieve % GDS scores at least in-line with Hampshire averages once again.

2022 - At GBP, 65% of the current (Year 2 2022) cohort reached the Expected Standard (EXS) in Reading, Writing Mathematics and Science which is above the National average of 53.2% and the Hampshire average of 57.5%. This has now been the case for the past 3 year's data.
