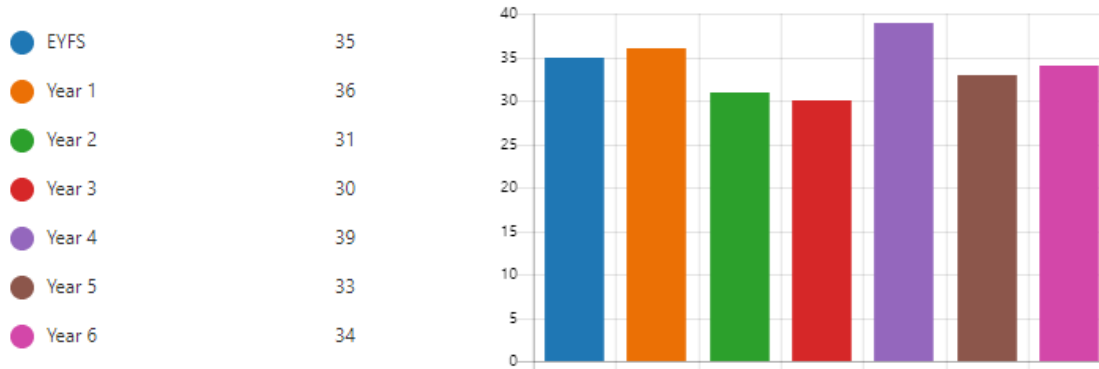


# GBP Parent /Carer Survey – July 2021 Analysis

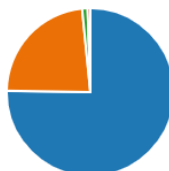

Some families want more homework – some less. Some love the creative projects whereas others like the structured skill practicing activities set. It is hard to please everyone here. We want our children to get into good homeworking habits ready for secondary school but also have the chance for down time and play as well. We feel that Seesaw is giving us more scope with homework too.

We do our best in those circumstances to put other strategies in place so that they can succeed but still ensure they work on practicing good values. We continue to use CPOMS where significant poor behaviour is reported so our Leadership Team are notified. This helps us coach our staff on what to do if they need assistance.
