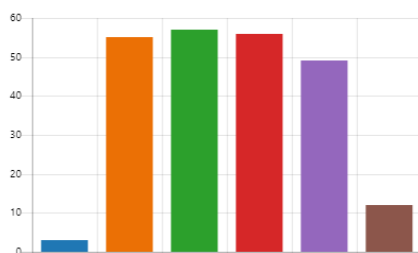


Children's Questionnaire Summer Term 2021

Our team adapted the curriculum really well to ensure the children had good access to missed content as well as ensuring current year group learning was really engaging as well as of course covid secure. We recruited extra learning support assistants since September to help deliver/support our curriculum teaching more effectively and increased teaching capacity in some year groups too so that the children had extra support. Repeating this for 2021/22 too. Early morning interventions in Reading and English were carried out successfully, leading to children accessing pre-teaching and consolidation of skills and building on their confidence.

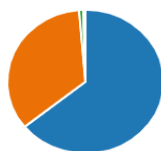

We will encourage our chn to ask for feedback if they are still unsure – the team will happily give you this time so they can achieve even more!
