## Home School Agreement

*“All children have the right to an education” UNCRC Article 28.*

At Great Binfields Primary we believe that all children have the right to be challenged through a high quality education that fully develops their personality and talents and encourages respect for others. To achieve this we recognise the following responsibilities:

### School Staff & Governors’ responsibilities

- To provide regular information regarding the children’s education and school events.
- To be available to discuss a child’s progress at appropriate times.
- To teach a creative and flexible curriculum matched to each individual’s needs.

### Pupils’ responsibilities

- To come to school in correct, named uniform; on time by 8.50 am; with necessary equipment e.g. PE kit / book bag / homework / water bottle / packed lunch / lunch money.
- To have respect for themselves, others, people’s property and the school environment.
- To be polite, truthful and honest to everyone in the school community.
- To work hard and try their best to achieve during lessons.

### Family adults’ responsibilities

- To ensure your child attends school regularly (provide prompt explanation of absence, contact school on first day).
- To make sure he/she arrives on time for registration at 8.50 a.m.
- To encourage him/her to have a positive attitude towards learning.
- To attend open evenings and respond to reports and letters.
- To support School and Class Charters.
- To inform the school of any personal circumstances that may affect your child’s education.
- To assist your child’s progress through listening to them read regularly and supporting homework tasks.
